St Peter's Evening Fellowship - Living and Dying in a Victorian City

The next meeting of St Peter's Evening Fellowship is on Thursday 5th July in the Brostoff Hall starting at 7:30 pm. Alan Pugh, a Leeds City Guide, will be telling us about Beckett Street Cemetery in Leeds. Veterans of the Charge of the Light Brigade, poets, trade unionists and celebrated philanthropists are all gathered here. Alongside them are rows of the so-called guinea graves. They enabled poorer people to provide a decent burial for their loved one in a communal plot with a shared headstone. The cost of one guinea included an inscription of up to 36 letters and some of the graves are inscribed with as many as 46 names learn about the cemetery's history, and some of the people buried there.


BBC Radio 4's Sunday Worship from Halifax Minster
