

## **Harrogate School of Theology & Mission**



Dr Gavin D'Costa, Professor in Catholic Theology at Bristol University speaks about *Christian-Jewish relations: new and difficult questions* 

The first lecture of the new season will ask us to consider if we can reconcile God's irrevocable covenant with the people of Israel and the belief that salvation is through Christ alone.
