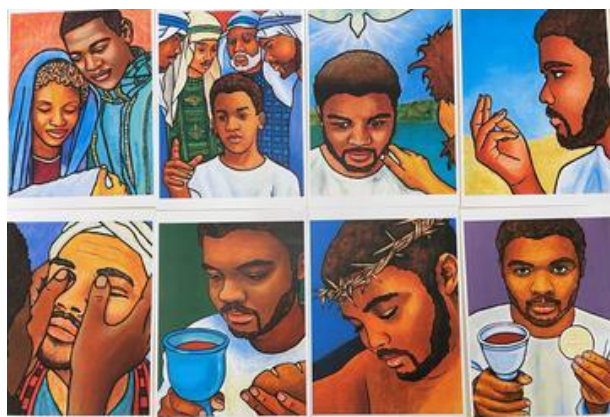
Eva Mileusnic – the artist featured in the next *Come to Know* exhibition



Eva is a second generation British/Hungarian born in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire. Her aim, through all her work, is to highlight and embrace the diversity of the cultural and national identities of the UK. She also hopes to help raise awareness and create dialogue around the ongoing refugee crisis. The exhibition will feature three pieces of her work - *Inter-National* a wall hanging and *Counter-Flow* and *Critical Mass* both featuring foot lasts - and runs from 25th June to 22nd July in the Glass Foyer.
