# The APCM is this Tuesday 7.00pm in Church

In May each year we gather to review the past twelve months; to elect Churchwardens and new Parish Church Council (PCC) members; to hear reports and to ask questions; and to look to the year ahead. The Annual Meeting this year will take place in Church on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> May at 7:00 pm. I am delighted that Sian Lockwood and Mike Davies have agreed to stand for re-election as Churchwardens for the coming year. There remain six spaces available for new members of the PCC. ### Could you serve on the Parochial Church Council?

Our Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) takes place this Tuesday, 20<sup>th</sup> May, at 7.00pm in St Peter's Church.

One thing we do at that meeting is elect new members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC). The PCC is the key decision-making body in the life of the Church. It consists of Clergy, Churchwardens and others elected by the APCM. It is responsible for sharing the leadership, management and administration of a parish with the Vicar. To stand for election to the PCC you need to be an actual communicant, aged 16 or over, and not disqualified (e.g. by conviction of certain offences, disqualification as a company director or entry on a 'barred list') and must be on the church electoral roll (and, unless under 18, have been on the roll for at least six months).

This year we will have space for six new elected council members. If you would like to find out more, then do talk with one of the Clergy, Churchwardens or existing members of the PCC. The necessary paperwork is now available on the Welcome Desk and on the PCC page of the church website.


