Dozens of lovely Hong Kongers from Harrogate and (fewer) dozens of wonderful volunteers have enjoyed each other's company, made friends and learned things about Hong Kong and the UK – finding a plumber, job applications,



talking to neighbours, expressing sensitive messages and more. We've covered festivals, history, heroines, heroes and villains. We've learned English and Cantonese. There's been plenty of tea, coffee and cake.

Some have found work or a better job, many have (studying hard in their own time) passed the *Life in the UK Test*, others are finding their way. Many thanks to Dr Anne Smith at *FaithAction* for creating Café Connect and much of the material we've used. Thanks to *everyone* for all the laughter, for your cheerful enthusiasm, for sharing yourselves generously – and, Hong Kongers, for your steady example of courage, faith, humility and good humour.



Very suddenly, *FaithAction* has lost its promised government funding for the programme. So, the question arises: what do we in Harrogate do next? There's an appetite for more, but in what format? Will we continue to use learning materials? Where will we meet? What will the costs be? Could we be self-funding?


Netmakers: the next Frontlines event
