Celebrity Escape to Breakfast Club!

We were recently visited by presenter, Richie Anderson, celebrity house-hunter, Neil Jones — one of the professional dancers from *Strictly Come Dancing* — and the *Celebrity Escape to the Country* film crew. They came to film at Breakfast Club because, early in his career, Neil Jones had to rely on the kind of food service we provide here at St Peter's. The programme they were making is due to air on BBC One on Sunday 4th January at 7:00 pm. St Peter's is likely to make an appearance, but nothing is guaranteed! In the same way that we must decide on the focus of our Christmas, so programme-makers must decide what to put at the centre and what to leave out!



Neil Jones' story is a good reminder of the value of Breakfast Club — it offers a safe and warm place for people who find themselves up against it. As well as providing a practical service, it is a place where barriers are broken down and connections are made — part of our vision to 'feed hungry people around God's open, generous table'. We currently have vacancies for Breakfast Club team members on Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings. After the safer recruitment process, you would need to be available to volunteer between 7:30-9:15 am on your chosen day. Please ask one of the Clergy or Churchwardens if you'd like to know more.

The Revd Chris Clayton to be the next Vicar of Horsforth



I was delighted to be able to announce last Sunday that our Associate Vicar, Chris Clayton, is to become the next Vicar of St Margaret's Horsforth in the Diocese of Leeds. Chris has served St Peter's Parish with humility and distinction over the last seven and a half years. For the first four years he was a Curate in training and, since June 2022, he has been Associate Vicar.

Now he is moving on to take up an Incumbent responsibility. Strictly speaking, Chris will be licensed as Priest in Charge of Abbeylands Benefice in the Diocese of Leeds with the expectation that this will soon translate into Vicar of Horsforth. Chris' final Sunday at St Peter's will be 18th January. Chris' licensing will take place at St Margaret's Horsforth on Wednesday 25th February at 7.00pm. Further details soon!




New Year! New You? Welcome to the table!


