## Re-commissioning of the Lay Pastoral Care Team

I would like to introduce the newer members of our congregation to the work that our Pastoral Care Team undertakes on a regular basis. As the leader of this dedicated team, I am often approached by members of the congregation, family members or clergy to provide a valuable link with someone who may be in need of pastoral support. We provide spiritual, emotional and practical support to members of our congregation and wider community. Here is a more detailed look at our pastoral care team activities:

**Visits:** Visiting individuals and offering compassionate care, support, prayer and companionship during times of illness or bereavement at home, in hospital and in care homes. Wherever possible accompanying parishioners to medical appointments or assisting with practical needs such as shopping.

**Listening and Support:** We provide a safe space for people to share their concerns, worries and life stories.

**Home Communion:** We take Communion to those who are unable to attend Church services in hospital, care homes or housebound.

**Referrals:** We try wherever possible to connect people to appropriate resources including other support services. This includes referrals to the *Bereavement Journey Course* when applicable which the Church runs each year.



**Training and Development:** All of our Pastoral Care Team have received specific training in pastoral care and listening skills.

If you feel that offering pastoral care support is something you might consider doing, please contact me.


